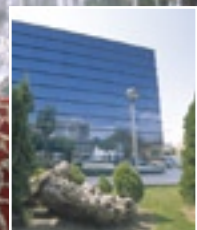

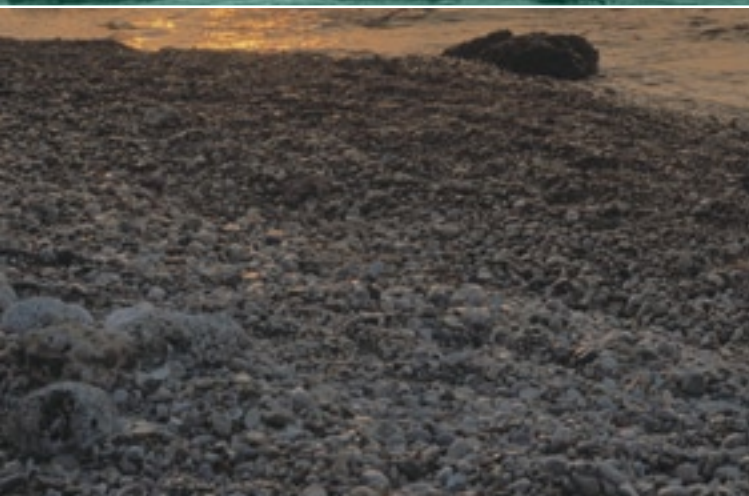

Vinaròs is tourism.



Vinaròs, a Mediterranean town located on the coast of Castellón, named Costa Azahar, possesses certain special characteristics which make it somewhat different. Here one can find coves with low cliffs and overlapping beaches, one can enjoy fiestas (Carnival, San Juan), pursue sporting activities (diving, golf and sailing), get to know its history, explore nature trails both along the coast and inland, go walking, go shopping in its old quarter (the most important shopping centre in the north of Castellón) and delight in the exquisite gastronomy of the region, especially Vinaròs' king prawns.





Vinaròs, the present with history.

Vinaròs maintains close links with its past through its religious and civil buildings of varying architectural influence (renaissance, baroque, modernist, etc.) and also through its archaeological sites. The city's identity can clearly be seen through its fiestas, traditions and customs, which have all been preserved over the passing of time.

In the areas near to Vinaròs the remains of the Iberian settlements Perengil and El Puig de la Misericordia are to be found. Nevertheless, the first references to Vinaròs as a town mention the conquest of the Muslim farmstead Beni Al-Arós by King Jaume I in 1233. Its excellent commerce links made it a target for both pirates and Berbers, which in turn, gave rise to the defensive architecture of the town, as exemplified by the archpriest's church of Ntra. Sra. de la Asunción, a clear example of

a fortified, religious building. The Archpriest's Church displays gothic origins, with later renaissance and baroque alterations. In the outlying areas of the town other religious buildings of great interest may be visited such as the shrine of Ntra. Sra. de la Misericordia or the San Gregorio chapel.

Some of the most emblematic buildings in Vinaròs have been restored, acquiring new functions (such as the W. Ayguals de Izco Municipal Auditorium, which used to be the church of the San Telmo convent). Other examples of this heritage are the bullring, the bullring closest to the sea in all of the Iberian Peninsula, the Municipal Market, built in 1929 (with especially attractive forms and colour) and the Santa Victoria Chapel.

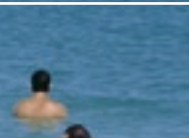
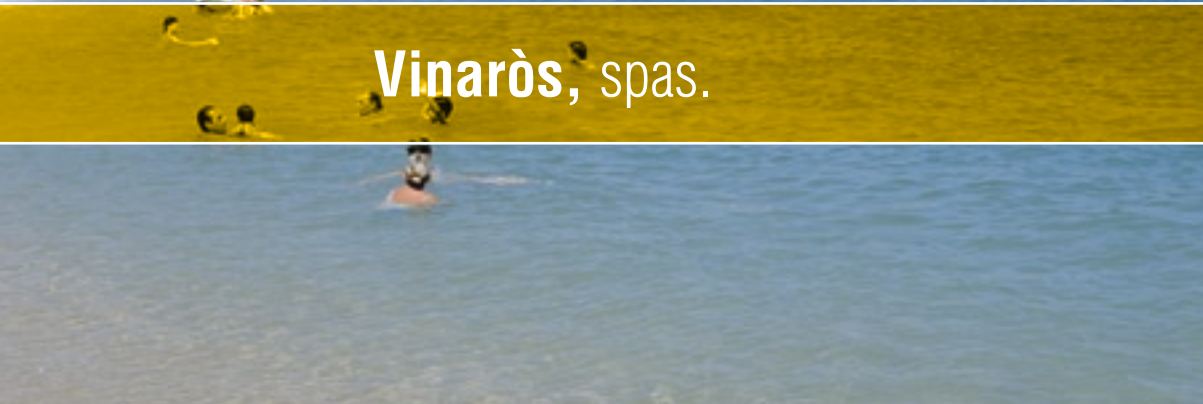
Certain civil constructions also deserve special mention: the Casa del

Consell from the XV Century, displaying the Alós family coat of arms on its façade, presents gothic decorations from the time; and the Casa de la Vila, built in 1784, which still boasts its original façade. Closer to the Twentieth Century we have Casa Giner, displaying a modernist style, where one may observe the vegetable motifs characteristic of this artistic movement. Another modernist building is the El Previsor Fishing Association, which is currently a retirement home and headquarters of the San Pedro Fisherman's guild.





Vinaròs, spas.



Vinaròs offers many different ways of enjoying the coast: from coves hidden between rocky outcrops, with their own unique landscape, to fine sand beaches along the promenade, with access for the disabled. All of these beaches possess the distinction of having received the ISO 14001 environ-

mental certificate from AENOR which guarantees that they are suitably maintained, cleaned and that the environment is fully respected.

The Vinaròs coastline is divided into three areas: the northern coves, the central beaches, and the southern coves. It is the beaches

of the central area which are the main tourist attraction: el Fortí beach, which is a Blue Flag beach; and Fora del Forat and Clot beaches, which are to be found next to the town centre and are united by the promenade, which offers a long stretch of restaurants, hotels, apartments, cafés and shops.

The coves, which are protected by low cliffs and offer typical Mediterranean flora such as Scrophulariaceae and the European Fan Palm, create a unique natural environment. In the area to the north of the urban centre one finds the coves and beaches of Sòl de Riu, Les Deveses, Les Timbes, Les Llanetes, La Foradada, El Pinar, El Saldo-nar, Els Cossis and Riu Cervol. The southern area of the coast-

line coincides with the beauty and personality characteristic of the northern coves: once again we find rocky outcrops, hidden little nooks, attractive, suggestive shapes and forms, and lush nature. These are the coves of Aiguadoliva, El Puntal, Les Salines, Les Roques, El Fondo de Bola and Els Pinets; all spots which naturally lead us to a state of tranquillity and restfulness.

The coves are clearly signposted and easily accessed.

The coves are also suitable for other kinds of activities in keeping with the unhurried peacefulness of the area, such as fishing from the shore or from the rocks and swimming and diving.





Vinaròs, Wealth of flavours.

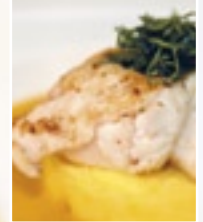
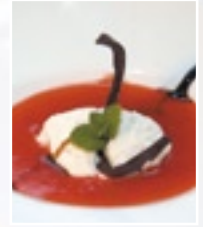
In Vinaròs' restaurants one may try a wide variety of dishes, thus enjoying the aromas and flavours of the Mediterranean.

The very characteristics of the town itself (for example, the active fishing port and the cultivation of fruit and vegetables) provide tourists with recipes from the area which will satisfy the most demanding

palate. Rice, sea-food and fish combine with the Vinaròs king prawn (renowned throughout the culinary world) as a basis for the most exquisite, varied dishes in the area.

For centuries the inhabitants of Vinaròs have used their know-how to extract the best products for the preparation of their dishes from

both sea and land. History has left a rich heritage of techniques and customs that present-day chefs have conserved and continue to respect. Innovation also has its place in our cuisine; giving rise to new combinations designed to surprise and delight the palate with unusual dishes, without forgetting the culinary culture from which they stem.

The true protagonist of Vinaròs' dishes is the king prawn. Those recipes which utilise the prawn are the most elaborate and offer the greatest variety of combinations. The town's chefs have managed to utilise the unique, excellent quality of the king prawns caught by the fishermen from the coast of Vinaròs. Our chefs know how to accompany the prawn with other fish and seafood, vegetables, sauces

and rice of different kinds; all types of interesting combinations which allow the creation of new recipes whilst conserving the most traditional dishes. Some excellent prawn preparation methods are: grilled; boiled; cooked with stones from the sea ("a la pedra"); or prepared with rum. Vinaròs' dishes are true Mediterranean cuisine, whilst offering their own singular touches. To really en-

joy these flavours why not try suquet de peix, all i pebre de rap, grills and fish casseroles, fideuà or arrossejat. As an excellent manner of finishing any meal one may indulge in typical desserts such as coc, brazo de gitano, pastisset or les casques ...all prepared following traditional recipes from Vinaròs.



Vinaròs, fiestas and traditions with a true Mediterranean flavour.

Vinaròs' carnival, which takes place during the month of February, is a point of convergence for tourists from both Spain and many other European countries. The open character of Vinaròs, the excellent organisation and the festive, fantasy-filled atmosphere are an invitation for one to participate, get dressed up and join in the fiesta.

Vinaròs welcomes in spring with the traditional Easter Holy Week (Semana Santa), one of the most deeply-rooted celebrations in the Valencia

region. Attending the processions of Maundy Thursday and Good Friday is especially recommended (above all the former as it is one of the few processions to still be celebrated on this day throughout the entire region of Valencia). Other tourist attractions of the Vinaròs Easter Holy Week are the coral concerts and the exhibition of the floats that will feature in the procession.

From June 23rd to June 30th will celebrate "La feria y fiestas de San Juan y San Pedro" which are consid-

erate the major festivity hold in this town. There will be performed several activities such as the amazing closing fireworks.

In the month of July it is the fishermen who are the protagonists and organise the celebrations on July the 16th in honour of the Virgin del Carmen, patron saint of all sailors.

The King Prawns fiestas are held during the month of August, several open-air activities are celebrated especially for tourists. Between 10th and 13th August take place the famous King Prawn Taste in the Vinaròs Promenade.

Vinaròs places all kinds of leisure activities within the reach of tourists. The sports facilities in Vinaròs allow one to pursue maritime sports during one's holidays such as diving, fishing, sailing or waterskiing, in Vinaròs' diving association and yachting club. In addition, boats may be hired in the harbour or one may go on organised trips. Activities

such as tennis, pelota or table tennis can be enjoyed in the Tennis Club's facilities. Horse riding and pony trekking are other possible activities in the Riding Centre. Competition and risk are essential ingredients of the Go-Kart circuit. Golf lovers can practice this sport in the Panorámica Golf Club only 8 km from Vinaròs. The Maestrat-Vinaròs aerodrome

offers the chance to make aerial trips, flying along the coast or enjoying the aerial views of Vinaròs, Peñíscola or the Ebro delta. In addition to the aforementioned facilities, Vinaròs has a sports centre, indoor swimming pool, five-sided football pitches, a full-sized football pitch and an athletics court.

The landscape also becomes another focal point for leisure pursuits, with activities such as hill-walking and cycle-tourism or pony trekking in the Riding Centre. Culture is very much alive in a town where one may go to the theatre, go to the cinema or see exhibitions. There are interesting excursions from Vinaròs to monumental cities

such as Peñíscola, Morella or Sant Mateu or the cave paintings in Barranco de la Valltorta, which has been declared a World Heritage Site. Nor must one overlook the chance of visiting areas of renowned natural beauty such as the River Ebro delta, the lakes of Encanyissada, the Islas Columbretes National Park or the Sierra de Irta and el Prat de

Cabanes-Torreblanca or the relatively unknown, yet intriguing region of Tinença de Benifassà. As for the city itself, tourists can explore the many shops and stroll along the promenade or visit the fish market and attend a fish auction or chat on one of the many terraces or just enjoy the nightlife in the various pubs.

Vinaròs celebrates its Patron Saint's Day, San Sebastián. Procession in pilgrimage from the Church to the Santuario de la Misericordia. Finally, paella is shared out for the assistants.

[February]-[Vinaròs Carnival]

During ten days there are several parties and events, which reach their climax during the weekend with the group processions with extremely imaginative outfits and carnival music on the streets.

[March]-[Les botigues al carrer]

Exhibition of products from various shops from the Town Shopping Centre.

[March/April]-[Easter Holy Week]

This is one of the oldest celebrations in the Valencia region. The artistic quality of its processions and floats is very high.

[March/April]-[Mercado de los saberes]

Activity workshops and the interchange of know-how and customs, Vinaròs celebrates his solidarity week.

[last week in April]-[Vinaròs marathon]

A sporting event with a long history.

[last week in April]-[Vinaròs Feria de abril]

Vinaròs recreates the traditional feria de abril (from Seville); held on the promenade.

[May]-[Moda i comerç al carrer]

A fashion show with the collaboration of various businesses from the town in order to promote the Town Shopping Centre.

[June 23 to 30]-[Fiestas de San Juan and San Pedro]

Principal fiestas in the town with a large number of events which signify the beginning of the summer tourist season.

[July/August]-[Cinema beneath the stars]

Films cycle show for everyone every Wednesday in the Vinaròs Promenade.

[July]-["Ciutat de Vinaròs" triathlon]

National sporting event involving many participants.

[July]-[Festival de Cortometrajes de Vinaròs "Agustí Comes"]

National short film festival.

[July 16]-[Fiestas de la Virgen del Carmen]

Mass and traditional maritime procession.

[last week in July]-[European Sand Sculptors Event]

International sand sculpting event on the Forbí beach, beside the promenade.

[August]-[King Prawn Fiestas]

Several open-air activities especially aimed at tourists. Between 10 th and 13 th August take place the famous King Prawn Taste in the Vinaròs Promenade.

[September]-[Anniversary of the granting of township status to Vinaròs]

Culturally-related events. Guided tours, exhibition and concerts.

[September]-[National King Prawn Cooking Competition]

National competition attended by expert chefs who prepare dishes based upon the most-renowned product from Vinaròs: the king prawn.

[September]-[Les botigues al carrer]

Exhibition of products from various shops from the Town Shopping Centre.

[First weekend November]-["Ciutat de Vinaròs" Music International Competition]

Musical competition attended by various musicians.

[November]-[Month of Rice]

Various restaurants in the town create special menus based on rice.

[Biannual Painting Competition "Ciutat de Vinaròs"]

National painting competition.

[Literary Competition "Ciutat de Vinaròs"]

National literary competition.

[Human Rights Film Festival]

National travelling competition.

[December]-[Christmas activities]

Different Kind of activities are performed : Christmas Chidren's Park , live nativity scene in front of the church, handicrafts fair...

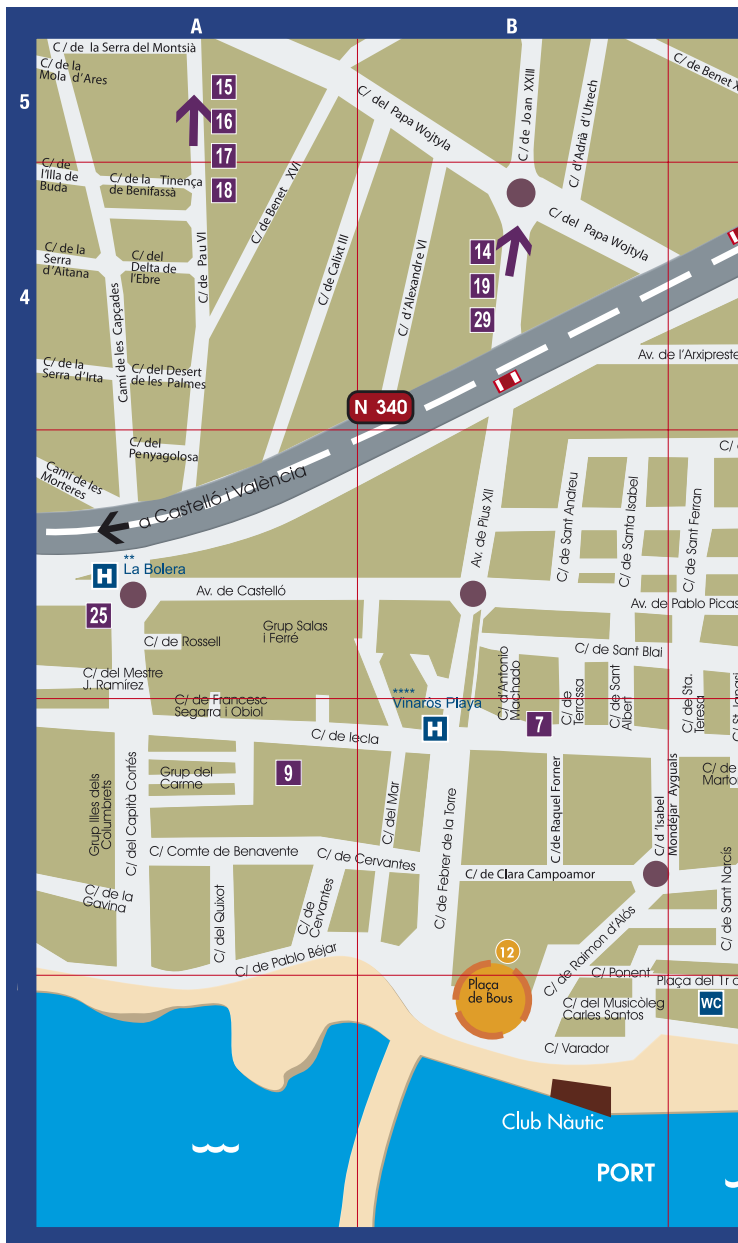
